JUDGING PROCESS

01 Judges

Each category will have a carefully selected cohort of senior project professionals who will judge each entry (ideally a minimum total of 6 judges per category). We can also call upon an independent adjudicator and our head of judges to oversee the fairness of the scoring.



02 Criteria

Each category has a specific criteria - judges will mark each entry based on the adherence of the criteria for their particular category.



03 Code of Conduct

To maintain professionalism and ethical behaviours we require all judges to agree to the awards' Code of Conduct in case of outside scrutiny.



04 Conflict of interest

To safeguard the integrity of the results, all judges are required to declare any conflict of interest should this arise with any of the entries they are judging.



05 Scores

Upon completion of the judging process – all of the scores from each judge will be consolidated/normalised and reviewed by an Awards' Steering Group (whilst taking into account any conflict of interest previously declared by any of the judges involved thus ensuring that the scores have not been affected by this).



06 Winners

Once decided upon by the Awards Steering Group, the winners of each category will remain confidential until they are announced at the Awards' Gala evening.
