## Entrance to the Nationals Park

### Parking

Complimentary parking in Garage C at Nationals Park is available for guests driving to the ballpark. The garage is located at the corner of N Street SE and First Street SE with the vehicle entrance on First Street SE. When entering the garage, drivers will need to let the parking attendant know that they are there for the event. Guests are encouraged to park near the elevator banks located on each level on the plaza side of the garage.

### 6 October (Day 1)

Attendees driving vehicles entering through Center Field Gate need to have their vehicles screened at the Main Security Office before entry. The Main Security Office is located on First Street SE next to the Right Field Gate. Vendors will pull their vehicles up to the barrier and inform the security office through the intercom next to the barrier that they are there for an event. Once the security team has cleared the vehicle, Attendees will pull their vehicles around to Center Field Gate on N Street SE. Once the vehicles are done unloading on the concourse, they need to park in Garage. C Please note that vehicles will need to hop the curb to get through Center Field Gates.

### 7-8 October (Days 2 & 3)

All attendees will be using the Media and Suites entrance. Once you have exited garage C, turn right to reach N Street. Turn left on N Street and walk down to the intersection of N Street and South Capitol Street SE. Turn left on South Capitol Street and walk about ¾ of the way down South Capitol Street. You will see signs for the Media & Suite Entrance on the stadium side

# Procedure for Badge Collection

## 6 October (Day 1)

Attendees driving vehicles entering through Center Field Gate need to have their vehicles screened at the Main Security Office before entry. The Main Security Office is located on First Street SE next to the Right Field Gate. Vendors will pull their vehicles up to the barrier and inform the security office through the intercom next to the barrier that they are there for an event. Once the security team has cleared the vehicle, Attendees will pull their vehicles around to Center Field Gate on N Street SE. Once the vehicles are done unloading on the concourse, they need to park in Garage. C Please note that vehicles will need to hop the curb to get through Center Field Gates. Attendees registered for Workshop Day 1 may enter the venue from 10:00 hrs. by showing their registration confirmation email or badge or logging into the Expo app to display their profile—no badge is required for access to the Home Batting Cage area or the conference space for stand setup.

## 7-8 October (Days 2 & 3)

All attendees can enter the stadium from 08:00 hrs. onwards on both days (i.e. 7th and 8th October 2025). Your name badge will be shared with you upon arrival at the venue during the Expo days. Please present your registration confirmation email OR you may log in to the Expo app and show the profile page, and an ID, at the registration desk to receive your badge. An Awards Night will follow the speaker session on Day 2, offering a celebratory close to the day's activities.

# Important Baggage/Luggage Policy Note

Nationals Park has implemented a clear bag policy for all guests entering the ballpark. Any bags larger than a clutch (5" by 7" x 3/4"), will no longer be permitted unless the bag is clear plastic, vinyl or PVC. Guests with diaper, medical or laptop bags will be admitted with additional screening measures upon entry

BinBox lockers will be available at the event to store bags that exceed the size limit. This service is free for Expo attendees.

Project Controls Expo staff will provide the attendees with clear bags at the entrance.

**Please note:** On Day 2, October 7<sup>th</sup>, attendees registered for dinner can collect their items from BinBox lockers until 11 PM. Attendees not registered for dinner can check out their items upon departure.

**Please take a look at the list of prohibited items here.**

## Prohibited Items

- Metal or glass containers of any kind
- Food items not in adherence to the following policy\*
- Hard coolers or ice chests
- Backpacks
- Non-collapsible umbrellas that don't fit in a bag of the maximum allowed size
- Brooms, poles and staffs of any kind
- Weapons\* (including, without limitation, pocket knives), fireworks and other illegal substances
- Camera lenses in excess of eight inches, tripods, monopods and selfie sticks
- Animals (except service animals)
- Beach balls and other inflatable items
- Laser pens and laser pointers
- Baseball bats
- Alcohol not purchased at the Nationals Baseball Stadium Complex\*
- Noisemakers not provided by the Nationals; This includes but is not limited to can-operated air horns, sirens, kazoos, whistles, and personal safety alarms. Note: Guests entering the ballpark with a personal safety alarm will be given the option of securing the device in their vehicle if they drove to the ballpark or securing it at one of the Binbox locations.
- Skateboards, hover boards, scooters for non-ADA use, and wheeled footwear
- Drones and other unmanned aerial vehicles (including, without limitation, airborne drones which are prohibited by law)
- Self-defense sprays (including, without limitation, pepper spray and mace)
- Toy guns or toy knives (including, without limitation, water guns)
- Helmets\*
- Any other item deemed dangerous or inappropriate or otherwise violating the Guest Conduct Policy
- \*Food - Single-serving food items may be brought into the Nationals Baseball Stadium Complex, as long as they are contained in one of the approved bags under the Nationals then-current bag policy, or carried in your hands so the food items can be safely screened by security
- \*Helmets - any guest riding a bike, scooter or motorcycle to Nationals Park may check their helmet at our complimentary bike valet located in Garage C at the corner of N & 1st Street, SE. Access to the valet is on First Street just left of the vehicle entrance.

**PERMITTED BAGS**  
Bags that are clear plastic and do not exceed 16" x 16" x 8"  
Small non-clear clutch bags measuring 5" x 7" x 3/4" or smaller  
Exceptions will be made for diaper bags (16x16x8 max) and for ADA/medically necessary items.

Clear plastic bag 16x16x8 maximum  
Clutch 5x7x3/4 or smaller  
diaper bag/backpack 16x16x8 maximum  
ADA/medically necessary items

**PROHIBITED BAGS**  
Any multicompartment or non-clear bag larger than 5" x 7" x 3/4"

Backpacks - solid or clear  
Non-clear drawstring bags  
Non-clear tote bags  
Laptop/camera bags  
Cooler bags - hard or soft-sided unless medical  
Purses  
Duffel bags  
Luggage of any kind
