Q. Describe the specific challenges or needs that led the company to seek project management training courses. What gaps or deficiencies were identified in the existing project management processes, and how were they impacting the organisation's performance or outcomes?

A. We need to enrol our employees on project management training to both upskill individuals on their project management knowledge, and assure our clients that our employees are suitably qualified. Formal training is a fundamental part of our project management career development pathway.

Q. Detail how the company addressed its challenges by enrolling employees in project management training courses. Specify the type of training program(s) selected, the duration of the training, and any customised elements tailored to the company's specific needs or industry.

A. Mott MacDonald is a corporate partner of the Association of Project Management (APM) and makes use of its standards and best practice. We have many ChPP chartered project professionals. Enrolling the right employees onto the APM Project Fundamentals Qualification (PFQ) and Project Management Qualification (PMQ) at the right time is very important to us.

We decided to outsource our project management training to a provider that specialised in it. We therefore ran cohorts with Training ByteSize that were 5 days in length, with delegates taking their exam on the last day (thus gaining their commitment).

We also liaised with ByteSize on the enrolment process and added a step to require all potential delegates to pass a PFQ Mock Exam before being added to our training waitlist. This helped to ensure all individuals had the fundamental knowledge required to attempt PMQ.
